

HUDSON VALLEY DANCER CHALLENGE

Betty and Bill were outstanding round dancers and their time practicing at home truly showed on the dance floor. If they learned a dance, they wanted to do it well. They took their dancing seriously but always found the joy of sharing their pleasure together.

Sadly, Betty was stricken with ovarian cancer and we lost her on July 2, 2007. We are glad to see Bill back on the dance floor. It was a promise he made to her to continue dancing. One of Betty's favorite round dances was "And I Love You So." I think that exemplifies our feelings about her.
